

CHANGES IN *THE RULE FOR SUBMISSION TO THE JOURNAL ACTA SLAVICA IAPONICA*

From the volume 38, the following changes will be applied. Authors whose **articles and research notes have been accepted for publication** will be asked to submit the following additional items:

- the abstract of the accepted publication in English (ca. 200 words)
- the list of all cited works that should be transliterated in the Latin script. For transliteration, the Library of Congress system should be applied <https://www.loc.gov/catdir/cpsd/roman.html>
- the short self-introduction for the List of Contributors (ca. 200 words). See samples: http://src-h.slav.hokudai.ac.jp/publicn/acta/37/LIST_OF_CONTRIBUTORS.pdf

The list of cited works should be formatted as follows:

Monographs

Surname, Name (Year). *Title with capital letters only for the first word and Proper Names*. Place: Publisher.

Surname, Name, Name Surname (Year). *Title with capital letters only for the first word and Proper Names* (xth edn.). (Series No.). Place: Publisher.

Articles in books

Surname, Name (Year). Article title with capital letters only for first word and Proper Names. Surname, Name, Name Surname, eds. *Book title with capital letters only for the first word and Proper Names*. (Book Series No.). Place: Publisher, page-page.

Articles in journals

Surname, Name (Year). Article title with capital letters only for first word and Proper Names. *Journal Title with capital letters only for the first word* No.: page-page.
